

Frequently Asked Questions

March 11th Macroeconomics Comprehensive exam:

1. Will the PhD macroeconomics comprehensive exam scheduled for March 11th cover any Macro I material? Answer: *Yes, there will be two questions contributed by Dr. Moore from Macro I, of which you can answer one. There will be three questions from Macro II as taught by Dr. McLeod, of which you must answer two. The comprehensive exam will involve answering three questions total (each written in a different exam book).*

2. Will the questions for the comprehensive be drawn from both the midterm and final exam? Answer: *Yes, for Macro II, for Macro I you have to ask Dr. Moore from Macro I.*

3. I took Macro 1 with Dr. Basu, does he write questions for the comp as well, or how should I prepare for material from Macro I? Answer: *No, the two questions from Macro I will come from Dr. Moore not Dr. Basu. You can prepare for Macro I by looking at Professor Moore's website for this class, or copies of exams. However, you have to get these materials from Dr. Moore.*

4. Where can I get the midterm and final exam for Macro II? Answer: Both exams are posted on my [ECGA 7020 web page](#) (or the [backup page](#)). Answers to the midterm were distributed in class and as handouts during the final review sessions. Most of the final exam answers are posted on the course web site. 5. We can answer at most one question from Macro 1 but can we answer all three questions from Macro II and none from Macro I? Answer: *Yes.*
